



The Child Advocacy Center in Mobile, Alabama, is seeking a full-time Executive Director. The Executive Director is responsible for leading, supervising, and providing oversight and direction to all operations of The Child Advocacy Center in accordance with its mission and vision to be a leading advocate in the healing and prevention of child sexual and severe physical abuse. The primary responsibilities include but are not limited to victim assistance, personnel and fiscal management, fundraising, public relations, policy development and administration, and planning and evaluation. This full-time position is hired by and directly accountable to the Board of Directors. The salary is commensurate with education, experience, and professional background.

The Child Advocacy Center is the Mobile community response to the problem of child sexual abuse. A wide range of services offered “under one roof” to sexually abused children and their non-offending family members helps them begin the healing process and prepare for the criminal justice proceedings. In the comfortable environment of the Center, twenty-eight (28) professionals from several different agencies (including Mobile County Sheriff’s Department, Mobile Police Department, Prichard Police Department, Mobile Department of Human Resources, Mobile County District Attorney’s Office, Lifelines Family Counseling Center, University of South Alabama Children’s Medical Center) work together as a team to provide healing, counseling, support, and prosecution services.
